A guide on how to plan your speech is included.

1. Study NB p 2; 21; SE **notes** on p 16, 23, 32-33, 49, 53, 54, 68, 100, 114 - 115, 147, 214.
2. On an A4 page write your name, grade, class and date at the top of the page.
3. Write a heading for every exercise e.g. NB p 2 no 1 -5 or SE p 33 Activity 2 a-f.
4. Write full sentences unless otherwise stipulated:
  - NB p 3 (bottom of page) 1 - 6
  - NB p 31 no 6 - 10
  - NB p 35 (bottom of page) no 1 - 5
  - SE p 68 no 2 a - e
  - SE p 24 Activity 10 no 3 a - c

### **How to plan and write my speech:**

An **original speech**, without using the exact words from authors and websites, needs careful planning.

- Read the article once, sometimes you will need to read it twice/thrice.
- Highlight **words/phrases** with information you want to use.
- Read the article again.
- Write down the words and phrases that you want to use in your oral on an A4 page.
- Check to see if you know/understand what the word/phrase means, or refer to, regarding your chosen theme.
- Decide on a specific strain of thought from the information that you wrote down that you want to use for your oral, i.e. the topic.  
An example: Theme: Family - Topic: Things that happen at Grandma's house when my parents aren't there.
- Arrange the words/phrases on a mind map.
- Choose the order in which you want to use the information.
- Write a rough draft using language that your friends will understand.
- Think of an interesting introduction and conclusion, e.g. a question, interesting or motivational quote, short sketch or something humorous.
- Edit and proofread the rough draft.
- Type the final draft as a google doc and submit it as an attachment. It is the Add with the paper clip icon, if possible.
